**AN ORDER FOR THE STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF MINIMUM HEALTH
STANDARD PROTOCOLS TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF SISON**

WHEREAS, the Constitution mandates that “the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them”;

WHEREAS, the significance of Proclamation No. 922 is to confer to the Local Government Units (LGUs) the same power as the President’s with the end in view of affording ease on procurement process, mandatory quarantine and travel restriction and price freeze under RA 7581, among others;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation No. 929 series of 2020, wherein Local Government Units are enjoined to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, appropriate response, and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the threat of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Republic Act No 7160 also known as the Local Government Code provides that within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and promote health and safety, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a threat to national security due to its grave repercussions to the ability of the State to maintain the well-being of Filipinos;

WHEREAS, The DOH has already declared a Local Transmission in Surigao City, with increasing number of Covid-19 cases and deaths;

WHEREAS, Infirmary and hospitals released information regarding the surge of COVID - 19 symptoms illness and will not accept admissions.

WHEREAS, the quick alarming morbidity and deaths caused by COVID-19 in the Philippines, the Municipality of Sison is duty-bound to place the entire municipality under community quarantine to intensify the implementation of precautionary and safety measures within the territorial jurisdiction of the locality.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KARISSA R. FETALVERO – PARONIA, RN, MAN, Municipal Mayor of Sison, Surigao del Norte, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. RESTRICTION OF MOBILITY OF PERSONS WITH HIGH RISK OF BEING INFECTED. Minors aged 0-21 years of age, senior citizens who are sixty (60) years old and above, those who are immune-compromised or with underlying illnesses and pregnant women are not allowed to go out of their homes except for the purposes of medical check -ups.

SECTION 2. The schedule of **TABO** will be on **Tuesday** and **Friday**.

SECTION 2.1 All food establishments should observe all precautionary measures.



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SECTION 2.2 Provide at least 2 washing area with liquid soap and clean water with 2 meters distance.

SECTION 2.3 Store owners must have a drop box as a money container and a cellophane to cover up the cashier to lessen physical contact.

SECTION 2.4 Alcohol spraying should be posted in the entrance and exit of the market.

SECTION 2.5 All the vendors shall have their own hand sanitizers or alcohols.

SECTION 2.6 Everyone should not spit anywhere.

SECTION 2.7 Everyone should observe social distancing of 2 meters if possible.

SECTION 2.8 All vendors should wear mask, and observe proper handling of goods.

SECTION 2.9 Sterilize all kitchen utensils by boiling for 5 minutes.

SECTION 2.10 Disinfection of every stall three (3) times a day using detergent and water.

SECTION 2.11 Disinfection of tables and chairs every after use using 1:100 Bleaching Solution. Example: 1 cup of Zonrox = 100 cups of water

SECTION 2.12 Residence from other places except from Surigao City is allowed to buy essentials during tabo.

SECTION 3. BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES.

Karenderias, government offices, schools, vegetable markets (wet and dry) and all other places where people frequently gather, will only accommodate 50% operational capacity.

SECTION 4. WEARING OF FACE MASK WHEN OUTSIDE HOME and SOCIAL DISTANCING. Any person who shall go outside of his/her home shall wear a face mask and strictly observe social/physical distancing of 2 meters apart from other persons at all times.

SECTION 4.1 Penalty for not wearing of face mask under the Municipal Ordinance No 001 – 2020

4.1.1 First Offense - Php. 250.00

4.1.2 Second Offense – Php. 500.00

4.1.3 Third Offense – Php. 1,000.00

4.1.4 Succeeding Offense – Php. 1,500.00 and one (1) day community service

SECTION 4.2 Other violations. Philippine National Police (PNP) will hold all violators.

4.2.1 First Offense – 3 hours on hold at Municipal Gymnasium

4.2.2 Second Offense – 6 hours on hold at Municipal Gymnasium

4.2.3 Third Offense – file a case

SECTION 5. PROHIBITION OF RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES “STRICTLY NO MASS GATHERING”. The general public is prohibited to attend, participate in, and organize events that draw a huge number of attendees.

SECTION 6. ESTABLISHMENT OF CHECKPOINTS. There is hereby established municipal checkpoints at the entry and exit point in the entire municipality, which, if applicable, be merged with the checkpoints established by the neighboring municipalities, provided that policies, protocols and regulations do not contradict with that of the province as well as national rules and regulations.

6.1 BARANGAY CHECKPOINT. All barangays are encourage to implement checkpoints within their jurisdiction.

6.2 RESTRICTION OF ENTRY. All persons coming from Surigao City and other places or unauthorized individual are not allowed to enter the municipal premise. Except for the delivery of essential goods.



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6.2.1 ESSENTIAL GOODS DROP-OFF POINT AND PROCEDURE. The designated drop-off point of cargoes coming from the outside of Province of Surigao del Norte carrying essential goods will be at National Highway corner Desoloc Street near at Mante Store. The delivery personnel are advised to stay inside the cargo truck while the owner/freighters are in charge of unloading the commodities and conveying to their store/food establishment.

SECTION 7. TRAVEL AUTHORITY. The Travel Authority allows the holder to transact with any establishments upon presentation of his/her valid ID or any proof of identification. However, LGU will issue a travel authority for essential and medication purposes only.

SECTION 8. ALTERNATIVE WORK ARRANGEMENT IN LGU. The employee hereby advised to follow the schedule given by the Human Resource Management Officer.

SECTION 8.1 All regular employees and all Job Order employees are advised to render services thrice a week only effective on October 1, 2020, until further notice.

SECTION 8.2 All Department Heads shall follow the work schedule from Monday, Wednesday and Friday effective on October 1, 2020. Except if their presence is needed.

Human Resource Officer shall strategize that the shifting of employees shall meet the required 3 day per week. Shifting refers to any existing shifting schedule and shifting of assignments to perform frontline services.

LCE shall ensure that the workers providing essential services such as health workers, first responders, frontline services providers and the like are provided support mechanisms such as appropriate strategy to minimize face to face contact, health interventions such as stress debriefing.

Strict observance of CSC MC. No. 07, S. 2020 regarding alternative work week arrangement and support mechanisms for workers in the government is strictly enjoined for the duration of public state of emergency pursuant Proclamation No. 922.

SECTION 9. PREVENTIVE MEASURES TO AVOID TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19. The public and all other stakeholders are advised to follow the prescribed guidelines and preventive measures set by the Department of Health (DOH) and LGU advisories.

Should there be a confirmed COVID-19 case in a barangay, the LGU where the barangay is located shall order a lockdown in said affected barangay.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders, rules and regulations which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall be effective on **September 29, 2020 until lifted.** This order may also be supplemented by succeeding memoranda that shall be issued by the undersigned in order to address whatever developments that may happen thereafter.
